The opening reception of the exchange exhibition with Washington Korean American Artists Association (HMAA, Chairman Lee Yang-hee) and Hawaiian Korean Art Association (KAAH, Chairman Im In-ok) was held on the 8th.

The theme of the exhibition is "The New Homeland", which means that you can meet with 70 works expressing the sensibility that you felt when you left your home country and settled in America.

The exhibition will be held at the Verizon Gallery in Annandale, Va., For two months, starting on the 4th and lasting until June 3rd.
